IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THIS EDITION

In 2020, NOAA announced that it will eliminate paper publications of the annual Tide Tables and Tidal Current Tables beginning in 2021. In order to provide a similar printed resource for those who prefer a physical copy, Paradise Cay Publications has prepared this edition, it is designed to emulate the format and content of the official NOAA tide table books as closely as possible. Some significant exceptions are indicated below.

- NOAA was previously able to include tide and current predictions for foreign ports in the annual Tide Tables and Tidal Current Tables publications as part of an International Hydrographic Organization (IHO) agreement. This international data previously provided to NOAA and disseminated in the Tide Tables and Tidal Current Table is not available to the public and are therefore not offered in this publication.

- Some of the stations included in previous years have different naming conventions or have been replaced with more relevant reporting stations. As a result, some of the Tidal Differences (Table 2) may reference stations that are not included in the current edition.

- The USNO has historically provided the moonrise/moonset date, however the USNO website is down for extended maintenance throughout 2020, and as a result the moonrise/moonset data is currently not available and omitted from this edition. Should this data become available we will add it to future tide and tidal current publications.

- The sunrise/sunset times are obtained directly from NOAA, but the format of this data has changed. Rather than using a "local mean time" format, we have provided data from select cities in the areas covered in the publication. This data was obtained from NOAA directly.

- Some formatting has changed in both data and text content, relative to previous editions. We have noted as many of these changes as possible both in this disclaimer, and within the book where the change has occurred.

- The index format has been changed. The data we've compiled has been presented as accurately as possible but is to be used for reference purposes only - this volume does not fulfill any carriage requirements. We welcome any feedback, suggestions, or corrections as we continue to develop and refine this series of tide table books.
